BAGGAGE REGULATIONS AND SOME RECOMMENDATIONS



- Airlines allow maximum of 20 kgs per person as checkin baggage. One small handbag is allowed per person as cabin baggage, which should not weight more than 5 kgs.
- We suggest that you carry o1 set of clothes along with your daily utility items and other accessories in your hand baggage. This is just a precautionary measure in case your baggage is misplaced.
- Please note that airlines do not permit items like loose batteries, razor blades, nail cutter, scissors, knives, gels, any form of liquid, cigarette lighter in your hand baggage. If required carry such items in your check-in bag.


CLOTHING



 Carry 4/5 pairs of comfortable clothes like jeans/trousers, shirts/t-shirts, short pants, Punjabi suits/saris and necessary undergarments.

- You must carry sunglasses, a folding umbrella, swim wear and comfortable footwear preferably walking shoes.
- In China carry enough pair of comfortable clothes like jeans/ trousers, shirts/t-shirts, short pants, Punjabi suits, saris, comfortable walking shoes. Warm clothing like sweaters, thermals are essential if you are traveling during winters. Trousers/Punjabis suits are necessary for women, since many temples are forbidden to those who wear skirts.
- In Japan carry lightweight cottons and linens are recommended throughout summer. Warm clothing like sweaters, thermal wear, gloves and boots are essential if you are traveling during winters.
