

Later enjoy time at the falls. Later in the evening shop your hearts content at the Fashion Outlets Shopping Mall. Overnight in Buffalo. (B, L, D)



Day 3 Washington DC

Today, we check out & drive to Washington DC. En-route visit the Hershey's Chocolate World. An entertainment complex that gives all a fun insight into the world of Hersheys Chocolates. Overnight in Washington DC. (B, L, D)

Day 4 New York

Today, on a guided tour of Washington DC see the the Lincoln Memorial, the Korean Memorial and Capitol Hill. We also view the White House, home of the US President. (Due to security reasons permission to enter or go near the White House is not granted). Later we visit the National Air and Space Museum and gain a unique opportunity to view aircraft models and displays like the Wright Brothers' first aircraft and Charles Lindberg's 'Spirit of St Louis'. Later, drive to New York - the Big Apple. We check in to the hotel in Times Square, close to major attractions like Fifth Avenue, Radio City Music Hall, NBC Studios and Central Park. Overnight in New York. (B, D)

Day 5 New York

Today, drive to Battery Park and take the ferry to Liberty Island to see the famous Statue of Liberty. We then proceed on a guided tour of New York City - viewing such well known sights as 5th Avenue, Rockefeller Center, the United Nations Building and New York's lungs - the beautiful Central Park. We also stop at the 9/11 Memorial to pay homage to the hundreds of innocent lives in the World Trade Center attack. Later, we visit 'One World



Observatory', on levels 100, 101 and 102 of the main building of the rebuilt World Trade Center Complex in Lower Manhattan - the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, from where we get panoramic views of New York city. Overnight in New York. (B, L, D)

Day 6 Arrive in Toronto

Today, we take a flight to Toronto. Welcome to Toronto - the cultural, entertainment and financial capital of Canada. You will be met by your Tour Manager / Local Representative and taken you to your hotel (Check-in time is after 3.00pm). The evening is free to explore the city on your own. Overnight in Toronto. (D)

Day 7 Toronto and Niagara

Today, we go on a guided city tour of Toronto. See distinctive landmarks such as the City Hall, Queens Park, Chinatown, Toronto Harbour and the University of Toronto. We visit CN Tower - the world's tallest freestanding structure on land. Later, we drive to Niagara, where we take the 'Hornblower Cruise' to get a close-up experience of the magnificent Niagara Falls. (Due to weather conditions, the 'Hornblower Cruise' operates only from the last week of May). Next, we visit the Skylon Tower, the most famous landmark next to the Falls which is the tallest structure that overlooks falls, both from the American and the Canadian side. Overnight in Niagara. (B, D)

Day 8 Kingston and Ottawa

Today, we drive to Kingston to enjoy the beautiful '1000 Islands Cruise', during which we see many historical and scenic attractions and the majestic architecture of Boldt Castle. Later we drive to Ottawa - Canada's national capital. Overnight in Ottawa . (B, D)





Day 9 Ottawa and Montreal

Today, we proceed on a orientation tour of Ottawa. This tour takes us around a number of famous landmarks like the Parliament Hill, residence of the Prime Minister and Rideau Canal, the waterway that links the lakes and rivers between Ottawa and Kingston. Later we drive to Montreal and go on a city tour, during which we go around Old Port in the historic old Montreal area and visit the Notre Dame Basilica. We make a photo stop at St. Joseph Oratory and then visit Mount Royal Park, landscaped by Frederick Law Olmsted, best known for his work in New York's Central Park. Overnight in Montreal. (B, D)

Day 10 Quebec City

Today, we proceed on our full-day excursion to Quebec City, the provincial capital, we drive through the Upper and Lower Towns and see the Parliament Buildings, the Plains of Abraham, the Citadel, Chateau Frontenac, the Place d'Armes and Quebec National Assembly. Later, we drive to see the Montmorency Falls - 30 meters higher than the famous Niagara Falls. We then travel back to Montreal. Overnight in Montreal. (B, D)

Day 11 Return Home

Today, after breakfast your 'East Coast of USA & Canada' tour ends as you check out of the hotel. It's time to say goodbye to all the new friends you have made. LOCAL FLIGHTS WITHIN USA



- No baggage is allowed free of charge.
- First bag will be charged USD 25 (weight up to 23 kg) & second baggage will be charged USD 35 (weight up to 23 kg).

ON ARRIVAL INTO USA / CANADA



 All joining direct passengers will have to reach the respective hotel, on their own and check in.

BAGGAGE REGULATIONS AND SOME RECOMMENDATIONS



- The baggage allowance of USA/Canada for international ticket and internal tickets within USA/Canada is one piece per person as checkin baggage (max 23 kgs total) with total linear dimensions (length + height + width) not exceeding 62 inches each and a total of 107 inches for both. Please note that one bag should not weight more then 23kg.
- One small handbag per person is allowed with total dimension of 45 inches (max. 5 kgs).
- We suggest that you carry o1 set of clothes along with your daily utility items and other accessories in your hand baggage. This is just a precautionary measure in case your baggage is delayed / misplaced.

How to book your holiday

WHERE TO BOOK

Your own trusted SOTC's General Sales Agent or Travel Agent can book you on your SOTC Tour. If you are booking through SOTC's General Sales Agent or your own Travel Agent, please make all payments to them and they will pay us on your behalf. There is no additional cost to you, so do take advantage of SOTC's General Sales or Travel Agent's professional advice and service. Our General Sales Agent's office is located at UK, UAE, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Qatar, Kenya, Hong Kong, Tanzania, and Canada. In the United States we encourage you to book with your travel agent or call us directly on our TOLL FREE NO 1-877-827-SOTC.

TIMELIMIT

We would be happy to hold seats on the Tour of your choice provisionally, on a time limit of 4 days (Subject to availability of seats on that tour).

In order to secure your reservations on a definite basis, you would be required to complete the Booking Form and pay a deposit of US \$400 per person (Adult/Child), towards the cost of your tour, within 4 days.

BOOKING & DEPOSIT

You must complete and sign the official SOTC Booking Form enclosed in this brochure, which gives the Booking Conditions of the Tour. Please complete one booking Form per party. Along with the Booking Form, please enclose a non-refundable deposit interest free amount of US \$400 per person (Adult/Child). This said deposit amount would be adjusted towards the cost of the tour.

All cheques must be made payable either to your own Travel Agent or SOTC Travel Ltd. and sent to SOTC's General Sales Agent, nearest to you. For passengers booking from USA, all cheques must be made payable to your own Travel Agent or Horizon Travel Services LLC and mailed along with your booking form duly filled and signed to 356 Morning Glory Drive, Monroe, NJ 08831. Within a few days you will receive the SOTC Invoice and an Official Receipt. Your SOTC Invoice is a written confirmation of your Tour. However it is not valid for travel on the Tour.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is your responsibility to hold valid Travel Documents such as Passports, Visas, confirmed air tickets to be able to travel on the Tour. The cost of processing your Travel Documents is not included in the Tour Price and you are required to pay for them separately and shall be responsible for any delay in procuring the travel documents and consequential loss whatsoever. It would be best to check with your Travel Agent or SOTC's General Sales Agent nearest to you for advice and information. Please ensure with them that your travel document will be processed in time for your departure.

TICKETING
