

Day 1 Nairobi

Jambo! Welcome to Kenya. On arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be picked up and taken to your hotel in Nairobi (Check-in after 1500 hrs). Situated on the Nairobi River, the city is not only the largest and fastest growing city in Kenya, but one of the largest in Africa. Overnight in Nairobi . (D)





Day 2 Nairobi-Masai Mara

Today you proceed by your safari van towards the Masai Mara National Reserve, be prepared for a bumpy ride. Before departing you are taken to the Giraffe Centre where you get an opportunity to get up close and personal with the giraffes, as well as get a chance to feed them and also do a brief Orientation tour of this capital city. Enroute there is also a stop at the edge of the Great Rift Valley for a magnificent view of the valley and the two volcanoes. Maasai Mara National Reserve is an area of preserved savannah & its animals include lions, cheetahs, elephants, zebras and hippos. Wildebeest traverse its plains during their annual migration. Overnight in Masai Mara. (B,L, D)

Day 3 Masai Mara

Today you will be taken for an extensive drive into the reserve to see varied kinds of game, such as crocodiles and hippos resting in the water. Game drives are designed to take you close to the wildlife rich spots in the Maasai Mara, where your ranger spots the best possible game. In the afternoon return to your lodge. Overnight in Masai Mara. (B, PL, D)

Day 4 Masai Mara-Lake Elementaita

Early this morning you will be driven to Lake Elementaita, a shallow soda lake in the Great Rift Valley, which is home to pelicans, storks and flamingos. Overnight in Lake Elementaita. (B, L, D)



Day 5 Lake Elementaita - Nyahururu

Today you proceed towards Nayhururu to view the Thompson Falls, a scenic 74 m (243 ft) waterfall on the Ewaso Ng'iro river, named after fur trapper David Thompson. Upstream from the falls is one of the highest hippo pools in Kenya. Overnight in Nyahururu. (B, L, D)

Day 6 Nyahururu-Aberdare

This morning you are driven to the Solio Ranch, a privately-owned wildlife conservancy, geared toward rhino conservation. Here there is a good chance of your spotting these huge animals. Later we drive to Aberdare, picturesque, steep forested ravines and open moorland characterise the Aberdare National Park. Overnight in Aberdare. (B, L, D)

Day 7 Return Home

Today you take your flight home. It's time to say goodbye to all the new friends you have made. We hope you take back many happy memories of your SOTC holiday. We would like you to write and tell us how you enjoyed your holiday and give us your suggestions. (B)

ON ARRIVAL INTO AFRICA



- All passengers will be met by SOTC Tour Manager / Local Representative in the arrival hall outside the customs
- As other members of your group would be flying from different hubs, you would be required to wait for some time so that they can join you at the arrival area as common airport pick-up facility is provided for the entire group. Also in view of the common airport drop facility provided for your group, you would be required to travel to the airport along with other group members even though your flight time is later than other members of your group.

MEALS



- You have a choice of Veg / Jain / non-veg meals. The menus, are fixed in advance and a la carte is not possible.
- A combination of Indian and local meals is not possible. Most dinner are unlimited buffets, but it is requested that you do not waste food.

BAGGAGE REGULATIONS AND SOME RECOMMENDATIONS



- Airlines allow maximum of 23 kgs per person as checkin baggage. One small handbag is allowed per person as cabin baggage, which should not weight more than 5 kgs. Different airlines will have different baggage policies.
- We suggest that you carry one set of clothes along with your daily utility items and other accessories in your hand baggage. This is just a precautionary measure in case your baggage is misplaced.
- We advice that you travel as light as possible, since Porterage is not included in your tour price and carrying heavy luggage would be inconvenient. Prefer bags with wheels and sturdy handles, as they are more convenient.
- Please note that airlines do not permit items like loose batteries, razor blades, nail cutter, scissors, knives, gels, any form of liquid, cigarette lighter in your hand baggage. If required carry such items in your check-in bag.
- Please ensure that you do not place any valuables in your check-in bag. Carry your foreign currency / travel documents / jewelry / insurance in your hand bag.

HOTELS & ROOMS

 We advice that you keep all your valuables like money, passport, tickets and jewelry in the locker, in case you are staying for more than one day at the hotel.
- Please make sure that no damages are done to your hotel room during the stay, as the same would be charged to you directly by the hotel.
- Hotel rooms may have facilities like mini-bar, pay television channels, telephones etc. Please note that these facilities are not complimentary and will be charged as per actual usage.



 Please note that we will try our best to provide you with adjacent rooms that have been asked by you at the time of booking, but the same will be subject to availability at the time of check-in. It is also difficult to provide interconnecting rooms, however the tour manager and the hotel will try their best to ensure that you are provided with adjacent rooms wherever possible.

VACCINATION



 If you are traveling to Kenya, it is mandatory to get yourself vaccinated against Yellow Fever & oral polio vaccinations, 10 days prior to arrival into Kenya and carry the original certificates of the vaccinations along with you on your tour.

CLOTHING



Kenya:

It is recommended that you carry long sleeves shirts & trousers as it will help protect you against sun & mosquitoes. As you will be going on safari, pack comfortable walking shoes along with khaki, beige & brown casual clothes. Also carry warm jacket for game drives. A light rain coat is advisable to carry.

South Africa:

Lightweight clothing is advisable although evenings can be cool. Sun screen, hats and sunglasses are a must and remember that sunburn can occur even in overcast weather.
